WEEKDAY AND WEEKEND PARISH MASSES RESUME IMMEDI-ATELY

Dear parishioners,

With the easing of COVID-19 restrictions we are recommencing Weekday and Sunday Masses from this weekend May 23-24. However, in line with the Government's social distancing guidelines, between now and June 12th, we only allowed a maximum of 10 people at each Mass (including the Priest).

To ensure a fair approach and that as many parishioners as possible can attend a Mass, we will be managing our Mass attendance. And so, we ask all parishioners to register for which Mass (or Masses) they would like to attend over the next fortnight, and we will allocate you one or more Masses depending on the number of requests.

If you would like to attend a Mass, please email or call the parish office or call Fr Mario directly on 0429600711 to advise of your preferred days and times. We will then go through everyone's preference and allocate people accordingly. You will receive an email or phone call to let you know which Mass or Masses you have been allocated to. If your situation changes before the mass and you cannot come, please inform us so that your spot can be given to someone else. Also, please remember, for the safety of others, please do not come to the church if you are feeling unwell, have a temperature, or show any flu like symptoms.

This booking process and these restrictions will apply to all Weekday and Weekend Masses. In the case of Weekend Masses, one Mass will continue to be live-streamed from Padua chapel at the revised time of Sunday 9.00am for the time being, and there will be two other Masses held in the church on Saturday 5.00pm and Sunday 7.30am. These will not be live-streamed or recorded.

Thank you everyone for your patience and understanding during this time of transition back to some sort of normal situation for our parish worship. Can I simply encourage you all please, do not hold back from asking to come to Mass - just let us know that you want to come and when, and we will sort things out from our end. You are all most welcome and it would concern me more to learn that parishioners wanted to celebrate Mass but felt unfree to ask.
