ATTENDANCE OF PARISH MASSES FOR OUR CHURCH NOW UP TO 100

Dear Parishioners,

This past week, we received an update from the Archdiocese advising of an increase in the number of attendees permitted for places of worship. According to the **Industry COVID Safe Plan for Places of Worship in Queensland,** we are now allowed up to 100 people at one service depending on the size of the church. This is very welcome news to announce on this weekend when we celebrate both the Feast of St Anthony of Padua on June 13th and of Corpus Christi (the Body and Blood of Christ) on Sunday. I and our parish staff have been working hard to make sure that we can meet the requirements of the COVID Safe Plan and because of the adequate size of our church, I can now welcome you to come to our parish masses from this weekend up to a maximum of 100 participants.

One of the many requirements of the Plan is that all attendees still need to be recorded for each Mass. As a reminder, our recording procedure is as follows:

WEEKEND MASSES - Saturday 5.00pm, Sunday 7.30 & 9.30am

To allow entry to the church to be as quick and easy as possible, please try to use the *TryBooking* Link prior to attending Mass. However, if you cannot or you forget, that is OK - just come to the church and when you arrive, please be ready to quickly record your name and contact details on the sheets provided. It would help if you could bring your own pen too (to minimize multiple use and cleaning).

WEEKDAY MASSES - As per our normal schedule.

There is no pre-recording of your details needed as the number of attendees is smaller. However, on arriving at the church, please record your name and contact details (unless we already have them).

FOR ALL MASSES

Please remember that for the safety of others, do not come if you are feeling unwell, or show any flu like symptoms. Please also use the hand sanitizers provided, observe social distancing requirements, and follow the markers showing where you are able to sit, either as individuals or as a family group.

Finally, this weekend is the last time that I live-stream Sunday Mass. I hope you understand that the full participation in the Eucharist is through our presence with one another as a community in person, and that the use of social media has only been due to a health emergency.

St Anthony of Padua: Feast Day June 13th

St. Anthony of Padua, original name Fernando Martins de Bulhões. He was born 1195, Lisbon, Portuga and died June 13, 1231, Arcella, Verona. St Anthony was canonized 1232, and his feast day June 13), Franciscan friar, doctor of the church, and patron of the poor. Padua and Portugal claim him as their patron saint, and he is invoked for the return of lost property.



Anthony was born into a wealthy family and was raised in the church. He joined the Augustinian canons in 1210 and probably became a priest. In 1220 he joined the Franciscan order, hoping to preach to the Saracens (Muslims) and be martyred. On his way to Morocco, he became seriously ill and was forced to return home. However, his ship back to Portugal was blown off course and eventually landed in Sicily. Because of his continuing poor health, he was not allowed to pursue his missionary among the Saracens. Instead, work taught theology at Bologna, Italy, and at Montpellier, Toulouse, and Puy-en-Velay in southern France, winning great admiration as a preacher. He died en route to Padua, Italy, where he is buried.

Anthony was the most celebrated of St. Francis of Assisi's followers and had the reputation of a miracle worker. On January 16, 1946, Pope Pius XII declared him a doctor of the church. In art he is shown with a book, a heart, a flame, a lily, or the child Jesus.

SCPIPTUPAL GODE BY

Eucharist in Scripture

The gospel of John does not include any account of Jesus taking bread and wine and urging the disciples to 'do this in memory of me'. The three synoptic gospels, however, all feature these actions and words, as does Paul's first letter to the Corinthians, which predates all of the gospels. Rather than using these words of institution, the gospel of John includes an entire chapter much earlier in the gospel in which Jesus theologises about the image of himself as the Bread of Life. It is this discourse, more than the Last Supper accounts, that provides much of the theological understanding of Eucharist.


