Dear Parents/Care Givers,

The Kedron Parish invites families to join our 2021 Sacramental Program for First Holy Communion. If you attend another parish, you are advised to contact your local Parish to arrange for inclusion in your local program. Because we want to support families attending their local parish, our enrolment is limited to: our parish families, families of St. Anthony's, local state schools, or families whose other sacraments have been received through our programs.

In preparation for the Sacrament of Communion, you will be required to attend:

1. A parent-only information session on **Sunday 18th July at 11:00am or Wednesday 21st July at 7:00pm** at the Church of St Therese and St Anthony, 80 Turner Street, Kedron. At this session, there will be an overview of the sacrament, housekeeping details, and distribution of materials/workbooks.
2. Enrolment Mass: **Sunday 25th July at 4:00pm**
3. Preparation Workshop: **Sunday 22nd August (1:00 - 3:00pm)** (One parent or Sponsor must attend with the candidate, please no siblings)
4. First Holy Communion Masses: To be booked directly via Trybooking through the parish website (just like you would for a Weekend Mass). Enrolment via Trybooking will open closer to the date. You are welcome to attend any of the masses over two weekends:
 - a. **Aug 28th 5:00pm; Aug 29th 7:30am, 9:30am, 5:30pm**
 - b. **Sept 4th 5:00pm; Sept 5th 7:30am, 9:30am, 5:30pm**

In keeping with the Sacramental policy of the Archdiocese of Brisbane, the Sacramental Program is parish based, family-centered and school supported. The preparation requires commitment from you and your family to attend all activities that we offer and on your enrolment we have clear expectations that you will participate fully in the program. If you feel you are unable to commit your time this year, please consider taking this preparation journey at another time.

The Sacramental enrolment fee is \$100, payable by credit or debit card, and is payable to the parish at the time of enrolment. The fee is put towards administrative fees and resources including activity session materials, resources and books. If you are unable to meet this cost, please contact the Parish Office to discuss options. Section 3: Privacy collection statement

The parishes, schools and agencies of the Archdiocese of Brisbane (we, us or our) may collect, use and disclose personal information about you. We collect personal information directly from you and may also collect personal information passively through our website.

If you were baptised overseas, we are required by Church law to advise that overseas parish of other sacraments you have received. By consenting to the disclosure of your personal information, Australian Privacy Principle 8.1 does not apply and you agree that we do not have to take reasonable steps to ensure that information is treated in accordance with the Privacy Act.
