Dear Parents and Caregivers,

I am writing to invite you and your child (in Grade 5 or above) to enrol in St Therese and St Anthony's Sacrament of Reconciliation Preparation for 2022. Our parish program runs for three weeks. The first two weeks will consist of activities and information being sent to you via email for you to complete with your child, with the Sacrament to be celebrated on **Monday March 7th, 2022**.

There are three parts to the Reconciliation program: Choices, Forgiveness and the Celebration of Reconciliation. We will send out some material to support these topics via email, but feel free to add to or if need be, seek more information from us if your child has difficult questions.

It is our hope that our resources will support you and your family in preparing your son or daughter for this sacrament. As their parent, you have been their first and best teacher, the one who has helped shape their understanding of right, wrong, unconditional love, and the power of forgiveness.

On the night of the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation we will have the church open **from 4.00pm until 6.30pm**; you should plan on spending approximately **30 minutes** at the church that night. Your family is invited to come at a time that is convenient and will be asked to sit quietly to discuss a scripture reading and an examination of conscience. You will then introduce your child to the priest who will guide your child through this sacrament of forgiveness and reconciliation.

I am attaching an **Enrolment Form** which is **required** to be completed, signed, and returned by **14th February, 2022**. You are also welcome to scan through your documents to the below email address or bring the originals to either **Parent Information Session**. It is compulsory to attend one of these sessions to be held in Little Flower Church, on either:

Monday 14th Feb at 4.00pm or

Tuesday 15th Feb at 7.00pm
